Notes:

- 1 - tray has ears or tabs to support the wood block
- 2 - tin sheet side reinforcements
- 3 - tin sheet side reinforcements with tab to support wood block
- 4 - leather stamped UNITED STATES and W.HAWES
- 5 - leather stamped US MR
- 6 - leather stamped U.STATES
- 7 - makers mark embossed on block
- 8 - wedge shaped body
- 9 - block nailed in place, unable to view under block. Probing through nail holes revealed tin, but tray design is unknown.
- 10 - inner flap buttons to pocket
- 11 - pocket sewn into side of pouch
- 12 - pick & whisk tab sewn to shoulder strap
- 13 - coat button strap(s) sewn to pouch
- 14 - block is oversized and has stretched out the leather. It may be a replacement block.
- 15 - block is missing
- 16 - block originally nailed & screwed in place, wood platform is under tin tray.
- 17 - shoulder strap is marked 62
- 18 - pouch has 38th Foot markings
- 19 - pick & whisk attached to shoulder strap
- 20 - small 62nd Foot pewter button has replaced the original leather button
- 21 - have not yet examined this item
- 22 - shoulder strap sewn to cartridge box body, no buckles
- 23 - the pouch buckles appear to be bronze, not the typical iron
- 24 - shoulder strap has a brass buckle
