- 13 coat button strap(s) sewn to pouch
- 14 block is oversized and has stretched out the leather. It may be a replacement block.

- 16 block originally nailed & screwed in place, wood platform is under tin tray.
- 17 shoulder strap is marked 62
- 18 pouch has 38th Foot markings
- 19 pick & whisk attached to shoulder strap
- 20 small 62nd Foot pewter button has replaced the original leather button

- 22 shoulder strap sewn to cartridge box body, no buckles
- 23 the pouch buckles appear to be bronze, not the typical iron
